### Eating

There are rest areas for visitors to eat their own lunch. Vending machines are also available throughout the park. Contact the park for business days and other details.

### Park entrances/parking lots

By presenting the receipt from one parking lot, other ones in the park can be used free of charge on the same day. It is necessary to exit the park to enter a parking lot of a different entrance.

**For visitors with disabilities**  
Parking spaces for the disabled, multi-purpose restrooms, wheelchairs and electric carts (free to borrow) are available.

**For visitors with infants**  
Baby seats and chairs are available in restrooms, as well as nursing rooms and strollers (free to borrow).

**For visitors with pets**  
Please keep your dogs leashed in the park. The leash length must be within 2 meters. Dogs are not allowed in indoor areas, water playing facilities or rivers (except for guide, service and hearing dogs).

### Prohibited acts/articles (mainly including the following)

**All areas**

- Tents or parasols (except in the campsite and outdoor cooking areas)
- Use of fire (except in outdoor cooking areas) - Boomerangs
- Drones and radio-controlled toys (such as cars and airplanes)
- Kites and sports kites - Hard baseballs, wooden/metal bats
- Models with engines or batteries

**Chushin Zone/Takino no Mori Zone (West area Nature Museum and East areas)**

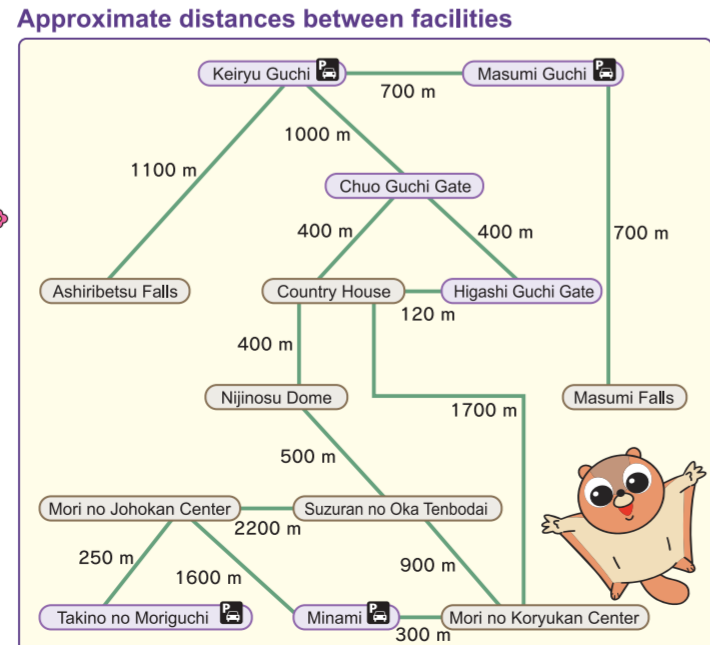
- Bicycles (incl. unicycles and bikes with training wheels, allowed only in designated areas)
- Kickboards, skateboards and roller skates

\* Other acts or articles prohibited by the park administrator.

**Gathering plants in the park is prohibited.**  
Violation of this rule may be punishable under the Urban Park Act.
